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Presentation Descriptions

Understanding EMDR Training and Consultation Experiences: What the Research Says by Liam Spicer

EMDR has continued to grow in its popularity, and rates of training have continued to rise internationally and locally in Australia. Despite the substantial research base for EMDR, and continued interest in its application among mental health practitioners, leading experts in the field have raised suggestions regarding some of the challenges in the integration of EMDR into clinical practice. This short session will summarise the research that has been conducted so far investigating EMDR training and consultation experiences, and other factors that may be associated with EMDR training attrition/retention. This will also focus on what further research is needed and aims to bring greater awareness of factors to be aware of when supporting EMDR consultees both in training and consultation to assist on the integration of this therapy into their practice.

Fidelity and Best Practice: An Interactive Session with Peers by Naomi Illife and Caroline Burrows

Join Naomi Illife and Caroline Burrows for a dynamic session focusing on the fidelity scale's pivotal role in enhancing EMDR clinical practice and clinician competency. This interactive session will explore the scale's development, offer an overview and key reminders of its scoring process, and highlight its importance in supporting consultees not only through accreditation, but enhancing effectiveness with clients overall. The session includes interactive group activities involving viewing and rating certain sessions in small groups, and a large group discussion will follow to give all consultants greater clarity and consistency regarding the utilisation of this scale.

A Review of the Research on EMDR's Effectiveness: Supporting Your Consultees with Up-To-Date Practice by Dr Stacey McMullen

In this session, Dr Stacey McMullen will highlight the current evidence base of EMDR in 2024, and present findings on recent research which has been conducted in the field of EMDR. This session will provide information on what populations now have consistent support for the application of EMDR, and also what further research is needed within the field. This will also include a discussion on what organisations and governing bodies support EMDR therapy internationally. The session will have an emphasis on the importance of staying up to date with the research as consultants in order to support consultees with up-to-date evidence based practice. Lastly, it will cover how you, and your consultees can remain engaged and up to date with advancements and developments in the field.

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Adapting EMDR consultation based on Learning style by Dr Jamie Marich

A gifted trainer and consultant is able to respond to the unique learning needs of each student. This task can seem daunting when trainers and consultants are entrusted with teaching a specific protocol and upholding standards. In this presentation, Dr. Jamie Marich who was a secondary instructor and English as a second language teacher before she became a therapist—shares her passion for pedagogy to help participants thrive as consultants. Using the framework of educational scholar Robert Gagné, whose word on information processing in the 1960s is remarkably similar to the adaptive information processing (AIP) model, Jamie will offer best practices and facilitate a discussion on workable solutions for consultation.

Increasing EMDR therapists' confidence and tackling challenges in EMDR Consultation by Dr Jamie Marich, Dr Sarah Schubert, Nadene Van Der Linden and Caroline Burrows

As consultants, increasing consultees confidence to effectively apply EMDR is one of the major goals, but often hurdles, through the EMDR training and consultation process. In this session you will hear from some of Australia's EMDR trainers and consultants on specific components of improving consultees confidence in the application and use of EMDR therapy in the form of mini-presentations. The second half of the session they will be joined by Dr Jamie Marich for a panel discussion including an interactive Q and A to discuss, reflect, and learn on how we can all improve our consultees confidence and ability to navigate challenges that may come up in the application of EMDR.
